Located to the southwest of Himeji Castle, the garden spans approximately 10,000 tsubo (about 3.5 hectares). The grounds feature a collection of nine distinct gardens, including a pond-centered stroll garden called Oyakata-no-niwa and a traditional sukiya-style teahouse garden with the tea room Soju-an. The tranquil, Edo-period atmosphere makes it a popular filming location for historical dramas and samurai period films. ✖From March 1st, to enter Koko-en Garden, you must purchase an entry ticket yourself at the castle on the day. Arima Onsen: Arima Onsen is a renowned hot spring located in Kobe, Hyogo Prefecture, and is counted among Japan's Three Oldest Hot Springs.
